July 22, 2008, STORRS CT - The U.S. Census Bureau's Boston Regional Office recently announced it will recruit managers for local census offices, in preparation for Census 2010, in both Hartford and Bridgeport.

Six (6) managers are being hired for each Early Local Census Office, which are expected to open by mid-fall this year. Job titles and links to the descriptions are given below.

In addition to submitting information about themselves, each candidate for these six (6) management jobs will be required to pass a written, one hour, multiple-choice, supervisory skills test. Over the next ten days, information sessions will be held in both Hartford and Bridgeport. The Management Test will be offered at the session on July 24th:

LCO managers will oversee activities such as recruiting and training, conduct address canvassing in early 2009 to update and verify the Census Bureau's Master Address File, collecting data from area residents and working with local officials to ensure an accurate count.

These managers will have an opportunity to assure that Connecticut residents are counted accurately. Many Federal and even State programs have the decennial Census as the basis for the distribution of funds to Connecticut's cities and towns.

Both Bridgeport (B) and Hartford (H) will hire each of these positions:

- Local census office manager — up to \$63,960 (B) and up to \$60,320 (H)
- Assistant manager for field operations — up to \$54,600 (B) and up to \$50,960 (H)
- Assistant manager for administration — up to \$47,840 (B) and up to \$44,200 (H)
- Assistant manager for quality assurance — up to \$47,840 (B) and up to \$44,200 (H)
- Assistant manager for recruiting — up to \$47,840 (B) and up to \$44,200
- Assistant manager for technology — up to \$47,840 (B) and up to \$44,200
